Cadet Liberty Policy

Overnight liberty will be granted to all cadets not in the duty section or **room/administratively restricted** over Parents Weekend. Liberty will commence upon completion of the last military obligation on Friday, 16 September and will expire at **0815** on Saturday, 17 September. Overnight liberty will be granted on Saturday, 17 September at 1300 for those **not required to attend the football game**; for those who must attend the football game overnight liberty will be granted **at the conclusion of the football game** to expire at 2200 on Sunday, 18 September. Restricted cadets are not authorized liberty and must attend the football game. Restricted cadets may route a special request to their Company Officer for overnight liberty. All requests will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis, but barring extraordinary circumstances, will not be approved.

Administratively Restricted cadets may entertain guests in the Chase Hall Parents' Room and in Leamy Hall per cadet guest schedule in the Cadet Regulations.

Ordering Meal and Football Tickets

All cadets who wish to attend this lunch will be placed on excusal.

Saturday Lunch tickets will be for sale August 29th through September 10th by visiting the Parents Weekend Division's Eventbrite website at: <http://cgaparentsweekend.eventbrite.com>. Tickets will be distributed to cadets by each company's Echo Liaison Officer one week before parent's weekend. All ticket purchases on Friday or Saturday of Parents Weekend must be in cash and will be carried out through Aramark.

Football ticket Information: Tickets will be available for purchase Friday from 0800-1500 in Lower Leamy (cash or check only). If cadets will be sitting with their families, they must have a ticket because all seats are assigned. Cadet tickets are free. When purchasing your tickets, please request your cadet ticket as well, so you are all seated together. Any cadets attending the game without guests will be seated in the Cadet section of the end zone. Cadets who are members of the football team, cheerleading team, and windjammers will sign up for their family/guests' tickets through their team coaches. Visitors are reminded that the consumption of alcohol is not permitted in Academy parking lots, and open-flame grills are not permitted on Academy grounds.

Parking/Shuttle Guidance

Primary parking for guests and parents will be at Crystal Mall on Friday, the 16th, and Saturday, the 17th. Crystal Mall is located off exit 82 on Interstate-95 at 850 Hartford Turnpike, Waterford, CT. Shuttle service from Crystal Mall will leave from the mall parking lot closest to the Olive Garden restaurant (b/n JCPenny's & Target). Shuttle service will provide transportation to and from Crystal Mall parking lot to Leamy Hall from 0730-1900. Handicap parking will be available in the CGA R-Lot (beside Chase Hall) on Friday and Saturday, with golf cart service to Leamy Hall.

Saturday morning, on-base parking will be open to all staff, cadets, parents, and guests. To alleviate traffic congestion around USCGA, cadets and parents are reminded to arrive early and make use of the off-base parking and shuttle service. On Sunday, 18 September, the USCGA campus will be open to all parents and guests.

Getting Around USCGA and Weather

The terrain of the USCGA campus contains numerous hills. Parents and guests are encouraged to wear comfortable walking shoes for events throughout the weekend. Golf carts will be available to provide transportation to those needing assistance throughout the campus on Friday and Saturday.
